90 of the nation's leading craft artists participate in juried, contemporary show

BOSTON (March 13, 2017) -- CraftBoston Spring, presented by the Society of Arts and Crafts, features the nation's leading craft artists from April 21-23 at the Cyclorama at the Boston Center for the Arts located on Tremont Street in Boston's South End. This juried exhibition makes available for sale handmade craft objects to the public.

Craft artists showcase functional works of art including home and garden decor, furniture and wearable art. CraftBoston, a biannual exhibition, provides opportunities for artists to connect with customers and collectors.

Executive Director of the Society Fabio J. Fernández commented, "CraftBoston Spring is a spectacular event that brings together thousands of people from around the country to celebrate and support craft.
