



'Fiber Stories' to feature Philly artist

A new virtual exhibition and retail show spotlights almost 50 of the best fiber artists from across the country, showcasing their work and emphasizing the compelling stories behind the artform. "Fiber Stories," created by the Society of Arts + Crafts, opens online July 16. The show highlights the full spectrum of fiber crafts, spanning traditional and avant garde materials and techniques related to the fiber arts and including knitting, weaving, basketry, felting and quilting. Artist Betsy Hershberg hand-knits fiber and beaded jewelry from her Philadelphia studio, using traditional knitted stitch making and her own original techniques to create one-of-a-kind pieces.
